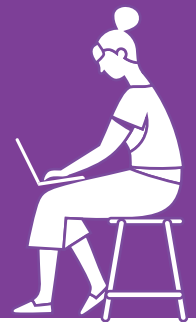




# VOLUNTEERING TO IMPROVE SKILLS AND ACHIEVEMENT

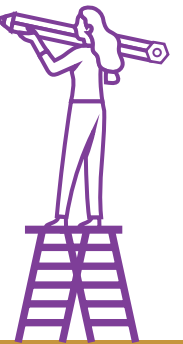
VISA is a simple, but effective way of strengthening the link between volunteering and employability, providing a tailored skills-focused reference for every volunteer involved.

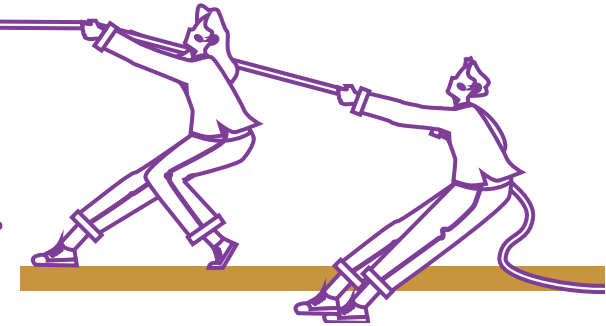
