

FLOWCHART FOR REFERRAL FOR ACTUAL OR SUSPECTED ABUSE: ADULTS

If the matter is urgent because an adult is in immediate danger phone 101 or 999 for the Police.

Safety

Are they safe? If you are concerned about an adult you could help stop abuse if you follow the safeguarding policy and procedure

It is not your responsibility to decide if abuse has happened.

It IS your responsibility to report it to the Safeguarding Lead and/ or appropriate authority
