

FLOWCHART FOR REFERRAL FOR ACTUAL OR SUSPECTED ABUSE: CHILDREN

If the matter is urgent because a child is in immediate danger phone 101 or 999 for the Police.

Safety
Are they safe? If you are concerned about a child you could help stop abuse if you follow the safeguarding policy and procedure
It is not your responsibility to decide if abuse has happened.
It IS your responsibility to report it to the Safeguarding Lead and/ or appropriate authority



Share

- Share your concerns/ information with your Safeguarding Lead.

- If there is immediate danger to the child call 101 or 999 for the Police.
